**TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE
UNITED STATES ARMY COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS:**

COME NOW the undersigned appellate government counsel,
pursuant to Rules 23 and 24 of this Honorable Court's Rules of
Practice and Procedure, and hereby move this Court for
additional time, until 20 February 2014, to file the
Government's brief in response to appellant's "motion to return
the record of trial to the convening authority for consideration
of and action on exculpatory and mitigating evidence acquired
after initial action but before the record should have been
forwarded."

On 3 February 2015, appellant served the above referenced
motion on this Honorable Court, and certified delivery to the

Government Appellate Division. Due to an internal oversight and miscommunication with the Court, this filing was not received nor reviewed by an attorney. Per this Court's internal rules, the Government's response was due to this Court yesterday, 11 February, 2015.

In order to provide sufficient time to prepare a response to appellant's brief and allow for adequate time to review the electronic record, the Government is requesting only an additional eight (8) days to file its brief (20 February 2015). Undersigned counsel does not expect that any additional delay will be necessary.
