ORDER

This matter is a petition for habeas corpus filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. Petitioner is confined at the United States Disciplinary Barracks in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Motion for Leave to Appear Pro Hac Vice filed December 18, 2018, (Doc. 2) is granted for good cause shown. John N. Maher is admitted to practice in the United States District Court for the District of Kansas for purposes of this case only.

Copies of this Order shall be transmitted to the parties and to the U. S. Attorney for the District of Kansas.
